IOWA MMJ POSITION: Against

Overview

HF 2128 would block long-time Iowa residents who want to attend some Iowa universities and community colleges from having access to in-state tuition.

HF 2123 will drive down graduation rates, discourage higher education and limit Iowa's workforce

- 24 states have moved in the opposite direction of the bill proposed and adopted "tuition equity". These states have seen a decrease in drop-out rates, increasing numbers of graduates who pursue a college degree, increase in student incomes and tax contributions and an array of other economic and social benefits.

HF 2123 undercuts teachers, parents and local communities' investments in young people

- Communities invest in their young people in countless ways across the state. This bill would undercut the hard work and sacrifices that parents and teachers make to support our kids.
